

The 2006 APICS Programming Competition follows the rules for the 2006 ICPC Northeast North America Regional Contest, with these additional details:

1. **Registration:** A team must be registered in the ICPC Registration System by 11:00 am, October 9.
2. **Contest Day Schedule:** Briefing: 12:30 - 1:00. Contest: 1:00 - 6:00. on Friday, October 13.
3. **Computing Environment:** each team is provided with a desktop computer running Windows XP Professional.

Programming languages are Java 5 (J2SE 1.5) and g++ (cygwin-b20 from <http://math.claremontmckenna.edu/ALee/g++/g++.html>).

Documentation for C/C++ and Java are available in the form of web pages, with IE browser.

Editors include vim (gvim 7.0) and emacs (emacs-21.3-1).  
No IDEs are permitted.

A team may bring 25 pages of printed materials into the contest area.  
A team may print 25 pages during the contest.

No electronic devices, including external keyboards, may be brought into the contest area.

4. **Contest Management:** The contest is managed and controlled by PC<sup>2</sup>, version 8.7.
